To effect this interchange of information, the Society has endorsed the journal, Tissue Engineering, as its official publication. The TERMIS World Congress is held every three years, and the Regional Meetings are held annually.

Conference Programme – TERMIS EU Conference 2010

The conference theme is ‘Development to Translation’, which will be addressed through a range of formats including Keynote lectures, academic symposia, contributed papers for oral and poster presentation, workshops, “hot-topic sessions” and industrial satellite sessions.

A broad range of clinical targets will be covered in the above areas.

Profile of participants

Tissue Engineering and Regenerative Medicine is a multi disciplinary field and delegates come from a variety of disciplines. This forum brings together clinicians from diverse specialties cell and molecular biologists, materials scientists and engineers.

There are 600 participants expected at TERMIS EU 2010, broken down geographically roughly 30% from UK& Ireland, 40% from Europe, and 30% from the rest of the world.

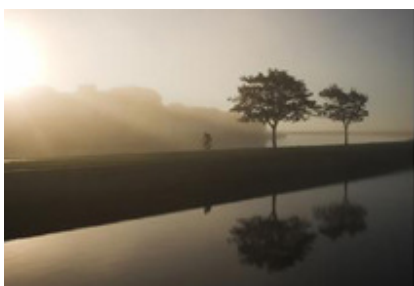
Conference Venue – Radisson Blu Hotel & Spa, Galway

Commercial Exhibition

A commercial exhibition will be held as a central feature of the TERMIS EU Conference. Due to the nature of the conference venue there will be several different exhibition zones, with coffee breaks held throughout the venue and good circulation of delegates through the exhibition areas.

It is anticipated that the exhibition will open on the evening of Monday 14th June and run full-day on Tuesday 15th June, Wednesday 16th June and Thursday 17th June.

Full Exhibition Booths in the Conference Centre area will be sold as 3m x 2m fully built shell-scheme stands, to include table, chairs, lights and electrical connections. Additional stands will be available in the poster area, and publishers stands will also be located in that room.

Smaller table stands will also be available in the lobby area of the hotel venue. These will be space-only with a 6' table and two chairs. A pop-up banner may be used behind the table or a banner on the front of the table by the exhibitor.

The number of Full Exhibition Booths available will be limited and will be allocated on a first-come basis.

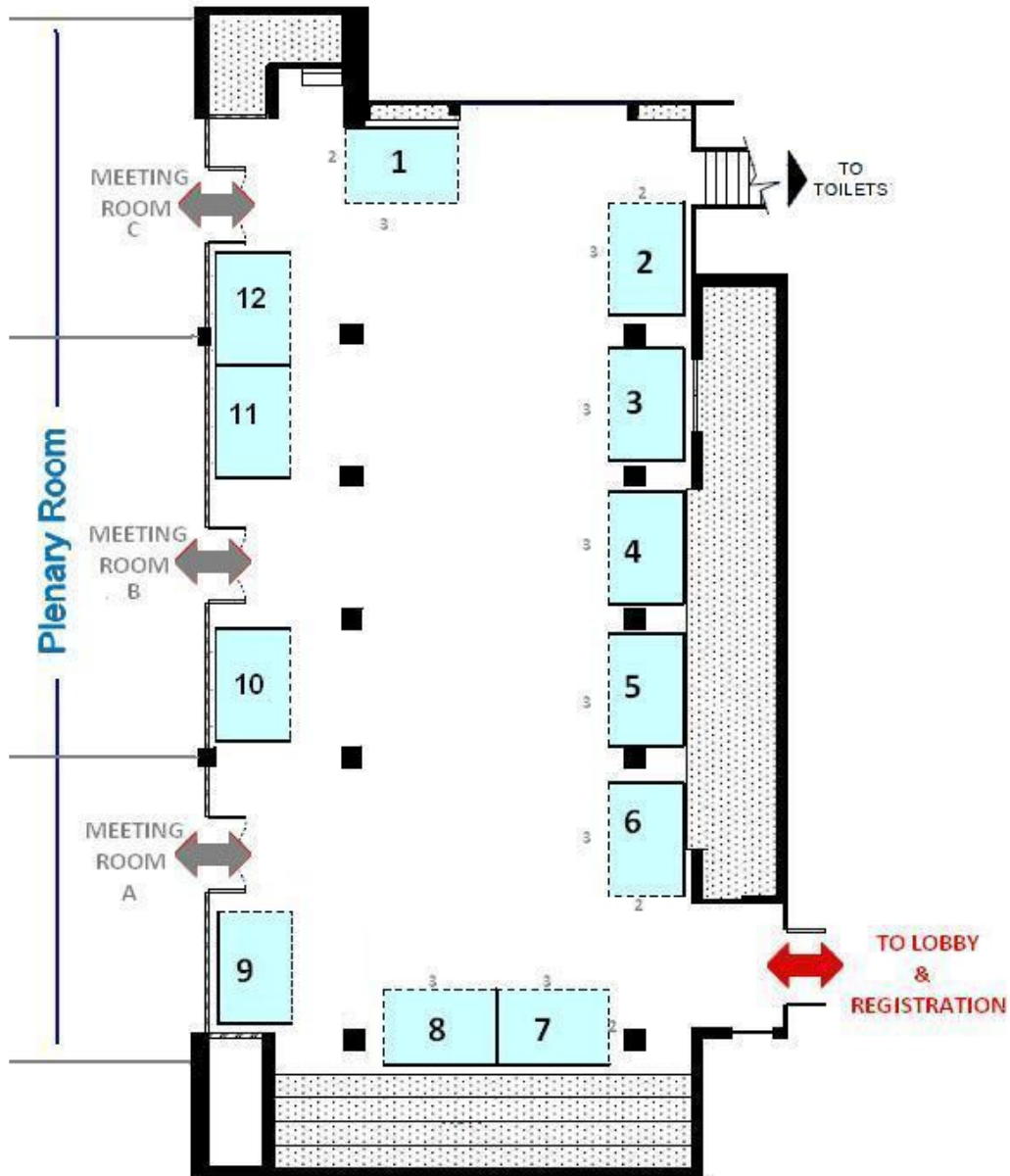
Publishers Area

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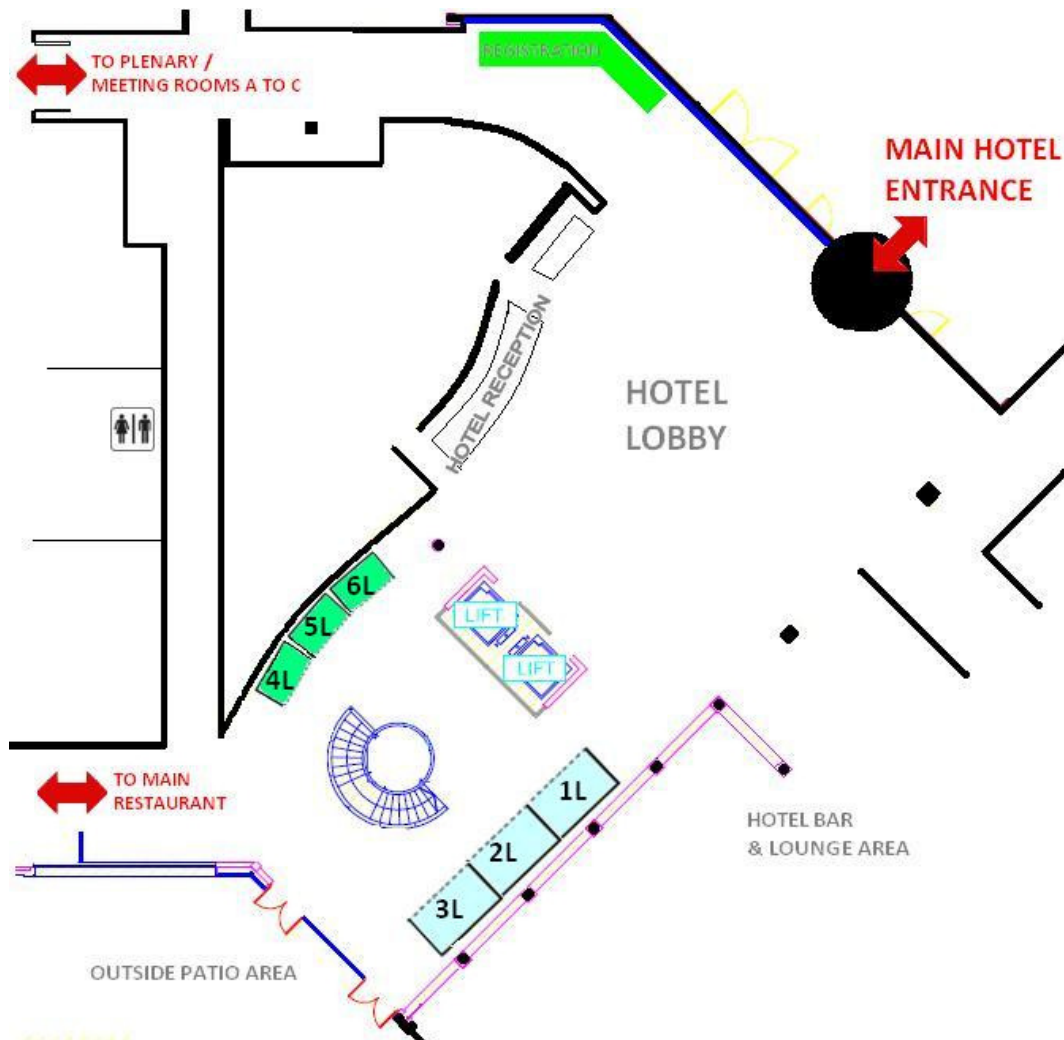

Exhibitor Information and Conditions

Upon confirmation of booking, exhibitors will receive a weblink for online booking of their staff badges, accommodation, social event tickets and other arrangements. Information will also be provided regarding shipping and deliveries, car-parking, etc.

Accommodation

The organizers have arranged special bedroom rates with The Radisson Blu Hotel for exhibitors, which can be booked through the Conference Secretariat via the online exhibitor form mentioned above. Rates will be €115 single room B&B and €130 double/twin room B&B.

Social Events

Exhibitors can attend the Opening Reception and daily lunch and coffee breaks. Tickets for the Gala Dinner on Wednesday 16th June can be booked by exhibitors for the special price of 65 euro per person.

Terms and Conditions for Sponsors & Exhibitors

An invoice for the full amount due will be issued upon receipt of the booking enquiry, and a booking is only confirmed upon receipt of payment. Priority on exhibition space location will be given to companies taking additional sponsorship items, otherwise exhibition space will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis once payment is received. Availability of many of the sponsorship opportunities is limited.

Refunds of exhibition space and sponsorship costs will be based on the following schedule:

Before 1st March 2010: 50% refund in event of cancellation by sponsor

On or after 1st March 2010: No refund available

In the event that the conference is postponed for any reason, the exhibitor/sponsor will not be entitled to cancel their booking or to obtain monetary compensation, but the benefits that have been agreed with the exhibitor/sponsor will remain in place for the rescheduled event. In the event that the conference is cancelled for any given reason, the Conference Secretariat will refund the exhibition/sponsorship money to the exhibitor/sponsor, minus any benefits that have been received by the exhibitor/sponsor prior to the cancellation and any expenses incurred by the Conference Secretariat with respect to the provision of the agreed benefits.

Exhibitors are entitled to have two staff in attendance to man their exhibition stand, with Prime and Supporting Sponsors entitled to 4 staff badges. Additional staff badges can be purchased for a price of 120 euro per person. Exhibitor passes can be upgraded to full delegate badges for 175 euro per person (permitting attendance at the scientific sessions).

Exhibitors taking a Full Exhibition Stand agree to be present for the full duration of the conference (from Monday 14th June-Thursday 17th June inclusive).

Exhibitors must have their own Employers Liability and Public Liability insurance in place, as well as insurance for any equipment being displayed on their exhibition stand. Exhibitors agree to maintain all materials and equipment within their allocated stand space. Exhibitors agree not to undertake any action that could be considered dangerous to participants or potentially damaging to the venue including not attaching anything to the walls of the venue.
